St. Paul's Cathedral, Melbourne Town Hall, Law Courts & Flagstaff Gardens, Queen Victoria Market, Royal Exhibition Buildings, Chinatown, Parliament House and Princess Theatre, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Visit Fitzroy Gardens and see Captain Cook's Cottage (opportunity to inspect at own expense), Melbourne Cricket Ground, Melbourne Park - National Tennis Centre, Flinders Street Station, Trendy Southbank on the river, Arts and Cultural Centre, Gracious tree lined St. Kilda Road, Albert Park Lake - Grand Prix site, Docklands - waterfront development, Bolte Bridge - spectacular city overview, Etihad Stadium at Docklands, Revitalised South Melbourne, Ornate Victorian terraced homes, Port Melbourne by the sea, Views of historic Williamstown, Trendy St. Kilda, Visit the Royal Botanic Gardens – perhaps enjoy a Devonshire Tea or walk by the lake, The Shrine of Remembrance.

## DAY 04 Melbourne/Phillip Island (Breakfast)

## GL384 Full Day SIC The Penguin Parade Tour [13:15pm-23:30pm]

Every evening at dusk the Little Penguins come home from the sea at Phillip Island. From the waves - across the beach - to the sand dunes - the Little Penguins can almost be touched as they waddle to their burrows. Sunset at Summerland Beach has drawn millions of visitors to Phillip Island. It is the nightly ritual of these little flightless birds which will enthrall you as you observe from the beach and the elevated boardwalk. Koalas - totally Australian - peering down from the gum trees where they live. Fat and furry, wet noses and a gentle smile of contented living on Phillip Island. Seals near the sea, basking in the late sunlight on half-tide rocks compliment this island, rich in wildlife which makes Phillip Island a very special place.

## > Tour Highlights

Western Port - water birds and mangroves, Panoramic views of French Island, Introductory penguin video, San Remo - fishing village, Look for bird life at the island wetlands (seasonal), Visit Churchill Island for afternoon tea (own expense), Opportunity to meet wallabies/kangaroos, Phillip Island Nature Park - a natural home for koalas, seals, shearwaters and Little Penguins, Koala Conservation Centre - look for koalas in their natural habitat from tree top boardwalks, A dinner stop will be made before or after the Penguin Parade (dependent on season), The Nobbies - a rocky outcrop, Seal Rocks - home to Australia's largest colony of fur seals, Witness the Penguin Parade on floodlit Summerland Beach, See penguin rookeries from an elevated boardwalk, Inspect the Visitor's Centre - an opportunity to learn about the life of the Little Penguin, During your evening return to Melbourne a contemporary movie feature will be screened.
